

THE LESSON STRUCTURE

Every lesson consists of 5 sections. Here is a little diagram on each of the sections that you use for every lesson:

THE BASICS OF EACH LESSON	Description
Prayer: Student or Parent	This is a chance for the parent to pray. We have supplied a guided prayer, but we encourage you to create your own if you feel up to it. These prayers should invite God to work through your time together.
The Teaching:	For this section you will need Internet access. Each video is online and can be followed by clicking on the link that's provided within each lesson.
Scripture Search:	For this section you will want to have your Bible and Luther's Small Catechism. We will give you a section of Scripture to read through and possible a reading from the small catechism. This is a great opportunity to get into the Bible and we encourage students to do the reading. Links to Biblegateway.com are also embedded into each lesson to centralize your teaching tools.
Question Time:	This is your opportunity to talk together about your lesson. We have a list of questions for you to work through. Don't rush through this portion of the lesson. This is where your student could begin to formulate their concept of God into thoughts and words. If a question comes up that you don't know the answer to, please reach out to us to help you find a comprehensive answer.
Prayer: Student or Parent	This a chance for the student to pray. There is a guided prayer available, but we encourage you to create your own.
