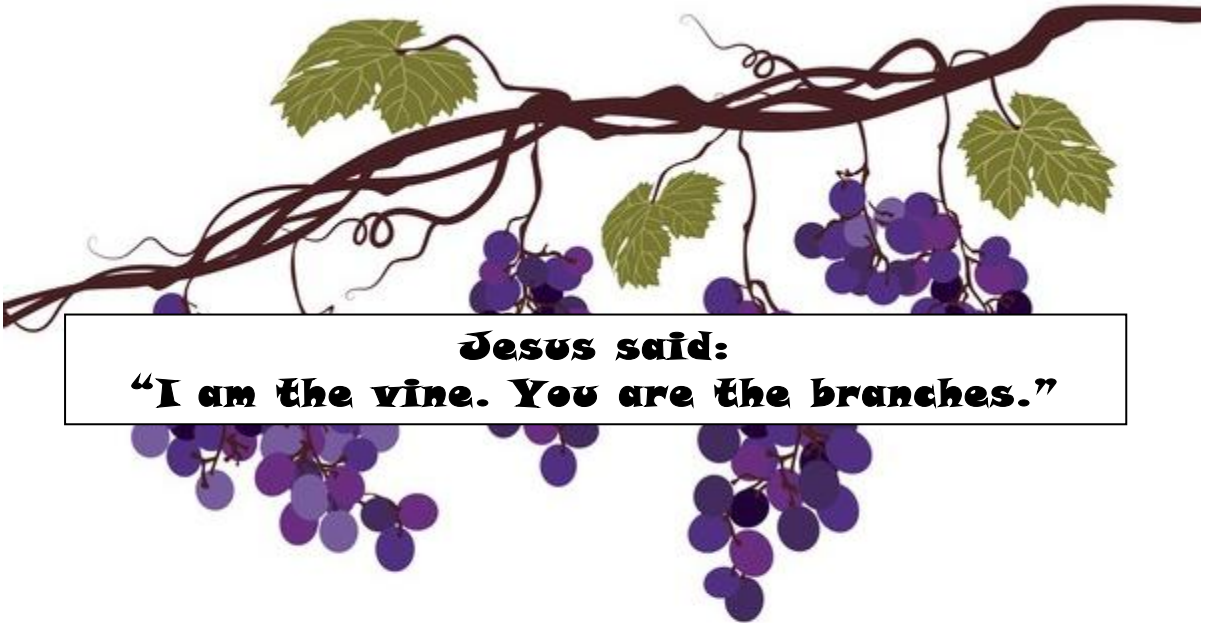

our God and our salvation. Amen**

GOD TEACHES US HIS TRUTH

THE FIRST EPISTLE READING - 2 Timothy 1:1-10

Timothy was raised in faith through his grandmother and mother.

Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by the will of God, according to the promise of life that is in Christ Jesus, ² To Timothy, my dear son: Grace, mercy and peace from God the Father and Christ Jesus our Lord. ³ I thank God, whom I serve, as my forefathers did, with a clear conscience, as night and day I constantly remember you in my prayers. ⁴ Recalling your tears, I long to see you, so that I may be filled with joy. ⁵ I have been reminded of your sincere faith, which first lived in your grandmother Lois and in your mother Eunice and, I am persuaded, now lives in you also. ⁶ For this reason I remind you to fan into flame the gift of God, which is in you through the laying on of my hands.

⁷ For God did not give us a spirit of timidity, but a spirit of power, of love and of self-discipline. ⁸ So do not be ashamed to testify about our Lord, or ashamed of me his prisoner. But join with me in suffering for the gospel, by the power of God, ⁹ who has saved us and called us to a holy life – not because of anything we have done but because of his own purpose and grace. This grace was given us in Christ Jesus before the beginning of time, ¹⁰ but it has now been revealed through the appearing of our Savior, Christ Jesus, who has destroyed death and has brought life and immortality to light through the gospel.

THE CHILDREN'S MESSAGE

THE SECOND EPISTLE READING - Titus 2:11-15

We are encouraged to grow in faithfulness to God and in all the things of God.

The grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all people. ¹² It teaches us to say "No" to ungodliness and worldly passions, and to live self-controlled, upright and godly lives in this present age, ¹³ while we wait for the blessed hope – the glorious appearing of our great God and Savior, Jesus Christ, ¹⁴ who gave himself for us to redeem us from all wickedness and to purify for himself a people that are his very own, eager to do what is good. ¹⁵ These, then, are the things you should teach. Encourage and rebuke with all authority. Do not let anyone despise you.

THE GOSPEL READING - John 15:1-8

Jesus explains that He is the true vine and we grow from Him and through Him.

[Jesus said] "I am the true vine, and my Father is the gardener. ² He cuts off every branch in me that bears no fruit, while every branch that does bear fruit he prunes so that it will be even more fruitful. ³ You are already clean because of the word I have spoken to you. ⁴ Remain in me, and I will remain in you. No branch can bear fruit by itself; it must remain in the vine. Neither can you bear fruit unless you remain in me. ⁵ I am the vine; you are the branches. If a man remains in me and I in him, he will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing. ⁶ If anyone does not remain in me, he is like a branch that is thrown away and withers; such branches are picked up, thrown into the fire and burned. ⁷ If you remain in me and my words remain in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be given you. ⁸ This is to my Father's glory, that you bear much fruit, showing yourselves to be my disciples."

Pastor: These are beautiful thoughts – beautiful truths – expressed by Jesus.

**All: Jesus, help us recognize You as the true vine
and treasure You as the true vine . . .
and trust You as our source of life and vitality.**

A PRAYER FOR OUR CONNECTION TO THE VINE AND OUR FRUIT-BEARING

OUR CONFESSION OF FAITH

Pastor: Do you believe in the one and only true God – the Triune God – Father, Son (Jesus), and Holy Spirit?

People: Yes, I believe in the one and only true God, the Triune God.

Pastor: Do you believe in God the Father?

People: Yes, I believe in the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth.

Pastor: Do you believe in Jesus Christ, His only Son?

**People: Yes, I believe in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord,
who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the virgin Mary,
suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died,
and was buried. He descended into hell.
The third day He rose again from the dead.
He ascended into heaven
and sits at the right hand of God, the Father Almighty.
From there He will come to judge the living and the dead.**

Pastor: Do you believe in the Holy Spirit?

**People: Yes, I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Christian Church,
the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins,
the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting.**

OUR CONFESSION OF SINS AND FAITH

Pastor: The God whom we worship reveal Himself in the Scriptures. He reveals Himself as the one and only true God. "I am the Lord, that is my name. I will not give my glory to another or my praise to idols." (Isaiah 42:8) "Hear this, people of God: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength." God's word also instructs us: "Whoever conceals his sins will not prosper, but he who confesses and forsakes them will obtain mercy." (Proverbs 28:13) People of God, loved by the Lord, let's go to God with contrite hearts and sincere trust. Let's confess our sinfulness and our faith in Jesus' sacrifice for us and God's gift of forgiveness.

**All: O almighty God, I am a poor miserable sinner.
I confess my sinfulness and my sin to You.
I deserve Your just punishment now and forever.
But I am heartily sorry for them . . . and sincerely repent of them.
I trust Your word that Jesus took the punishment I deserve on Himself.
I trust Your promises that because of Jesus' sacrifice,
You have forgiven my sin.
I am grateful. May my life show my gratefulness. Amen**

A TRIBUTE TO MOTHERS

Many of us have been wonderfully blessed by having God-fearing, godly mothers.
