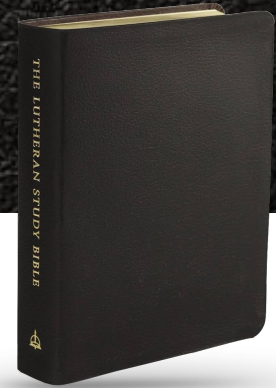


"ALL WAS VANITY"
